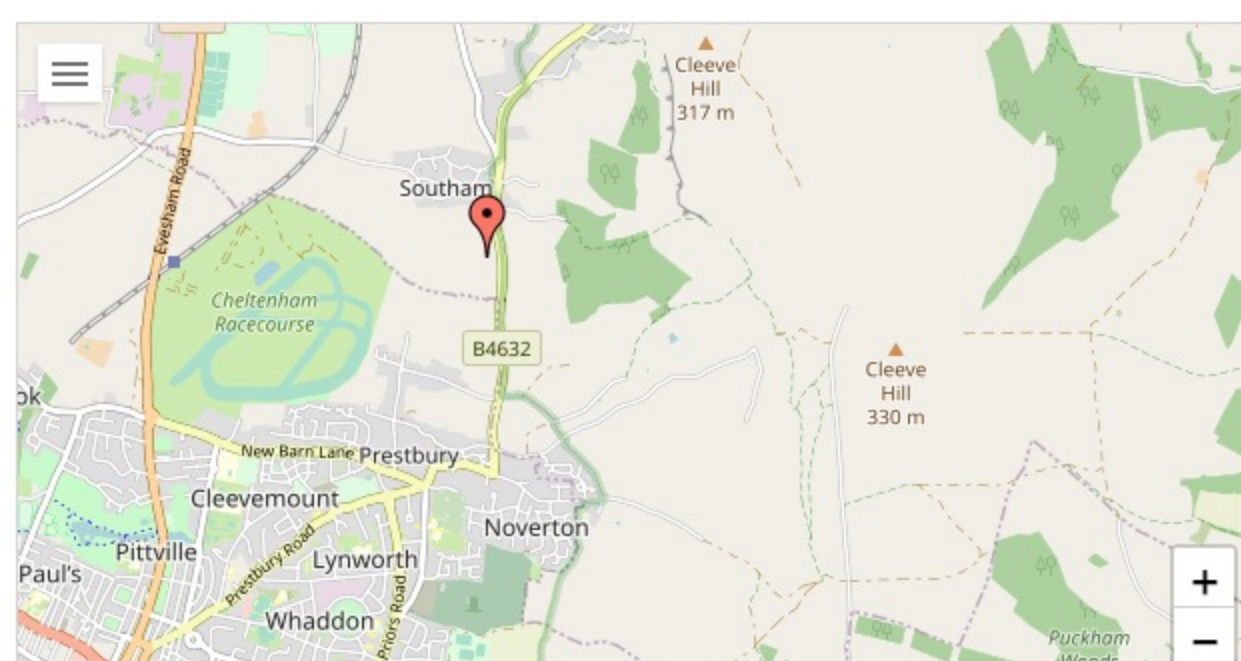
Transport Links

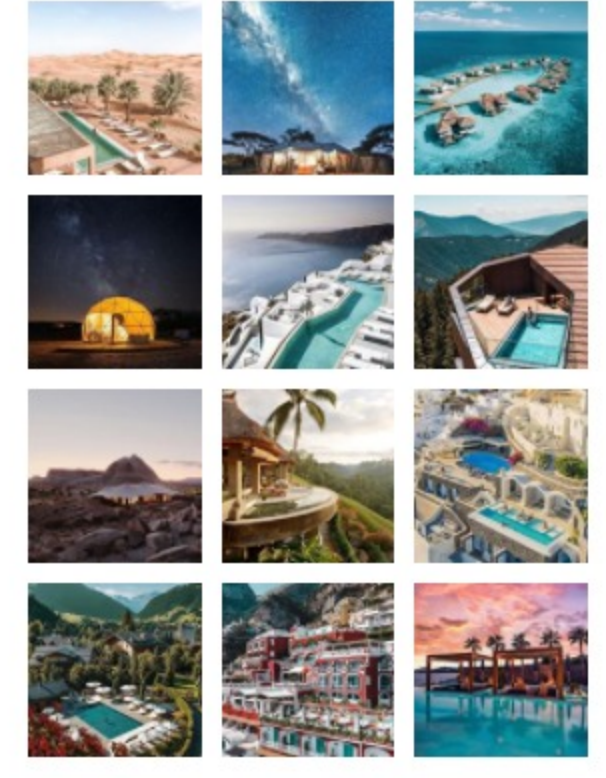
